

Sgt. Robert C. Priebe (1921-2001)

Robert Priebe was drafted into the Army Military Police at Fort Custer, Battle Creek, Michigan in 1943. He was later transferred to the Army Air Corps.

He served escorting prisoners of war by train from the east coast to the west coast where the prisoners worked on farms.

At Seymour Johnson, North Carolina Sgt. Priebe worked at the Air Force Embarkation Center Office. He was honorably discharged from the service on February 13, 1946.

He is survived by his wife Elizabeth and daughter Sandra, 3 grandchildren, and 2 great grandchildren.
